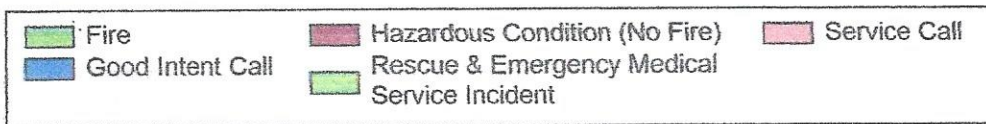
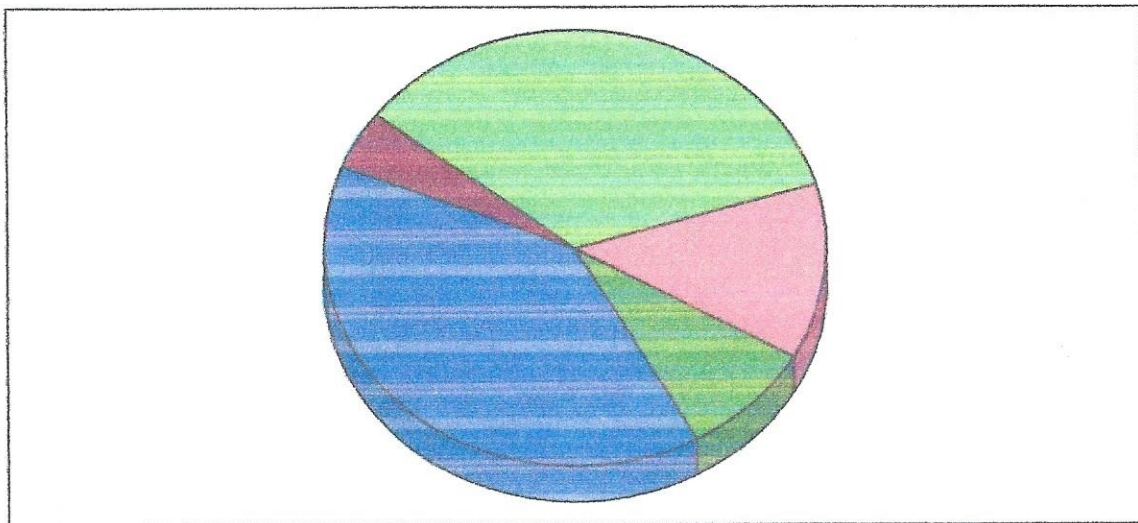

*BP392 (F550): We have been outfitting BR392 with Medical supplies, Wildland tools & equipment.

(still in need of purchasing extrication-cutting tools) We had ordered our fire dept logo's. When we receive them we will install them ourselves. Daggett had given us 4 SCBA packs, 4 mask, & 8 tanks.

Because of Daggett giving them to us, we saved \$3000.00 per unit (approx..\$12,000.00 new)
