NEWBERRY SPRINGS CSD STATS JANUARY 27, 2026 – FEBRUARY 23, 2026

During the past month, deputies handled 156 calls for service, took 22 reports, made 15 traffic stops and made 9 arrests in the unincorporated area of Newberry Springs.

MENTIONABLE EVENTS IN THE NEWBERRY SPRINGS JURISDICTION

On Friday, January 30, 2026 – Grand Theft Investigation: Deputy responded to the Clearway Solar Plant on Valley Center Road and Minneola Road regarding a security check. During the investigation, it was found that unknown suspect(s) cut the chain link fencing and stole about \$13,500.00 worth of copper wire.

On Saturday, February 7, 2026 – Possession of Stolen Vehicle and Drugs Arrest: Deputy conducted a traffic stop on a Chevy Tahoe on Minneola Road and Silver Valley Road and contacted driver, Luis Davalos and passenger, Juan Hernandez. The vehicle came back as being stolen out of Riverside County. Hernandez was also found in possession of suspected methamphetamine. Both were arrested and booked into the jail.

On Saturday, February 7, 2026 – Arson Arrest: Deputies responded to Ord Street and Pisgah Street for a disturbance call regarding a female throwing a flare into a motorhome. Upon deputy arrival, they found multiple vehicles and a trailer engulfed in flames. During the investigation, deputies determined suspect Brittany Blake had tossed a lit road flare into the motorhome causing major fire damage. Blake was arrested and booked into the jail.

On Tuesday, February 10, 2026 – Felony Warrant Arrest: Deputies responded to the Bagdad Café on National Trails Highway regarding Tannen Pruett trespassing at the location. Deputies located Pruett and found he had a NO BAIL violation of parole warrant and a \$10,000.00 Under the Fluence warrant. Pruett was arrested and booked into the jail.

On Thursday, February 12, 2026 – Cargo Theft Investigation: Deputy responded to Memorial Drive near the Mobile Gas Station regarding a report of cargo theft involving multiple trailers. Unknown suspect(s) cut the seals of the trailers and stole Kirkland Dog Food and other items.

On Sunday, February 15, 2026 – Felony Warrant Arrest: Deputy conducted a traffic stop on Newberry Road and Twin Lakes Drive and contacted Daneille Hurtz and Brandon Carroll.
