NEWBERRY SPRINGS CSD STATS MARCH 24, 2026 – APRIL 27, 2026

During the past month, deputies handled 197 calls for service, took 21 reports, made 14 traffic stops and made 4 arrests in the unincorporated area of Newberry Springs.

MENTIONABLE EVENTS IN THE NEWBERRY SPRINGS JURISDICTION

On Wednesday, March 25, 2026 – Felony Perjury Warrant Arrest: Deputies responded to a residence on Becker Road and contacted Alexis Discenzo, who was wanted on an active \$30,000.00 felony perjury warrant. Discenzo was arrested and booked at the jail.

On Saturday, March 28, 2026 – Felony Assault on Law Enforcement/Trespassing Arrest: Deputies responded to a residence on Valley Center Road regarding a female, who was trespassing inside the home and was refusing to leave. Upon deputy arrival, the female who was identified as Theresa Markowitz had barricaded herself in a back bedroom and refused to exit or leave the location. Deputies forced entry into the bedroom and Markowitz physically struck deputies when they tried to detain her. Markowitz was arrested and booked at the jail.

On Friday, April 10, 2026 – Cargo Theft Investigation: Deputy responded to the Mobil Gas Station on Memorial Drive regarding cargo theft from a trailer. Unknown suspect(s) cut the seal the semi-truck trailer and stole Kraft Cheese.

On Tuesday, April 14, 2026 – Cargo Theft Investigation: Driver reported being parked at a rest stop off Memorial Drive and his semi-truck trailer was broken into. Unknown suspect(s) cut the seal on the trailer and stole dairy products which consisted of cottage cheese and sour cream.

On Thursday, April 16, 2026 – Attempted Cargo Theft / Vandalism Investigation: Driver reported being parked at the Mobil Gas Station on Memorial Drive, when his semi-truck trailer was vandalized. Unknown suspect(s) attempted to break into the trailer by cutting

the seal and attempting to break the hinge to the padlock. Suspect(s) was unsuccessful but punctured one of the outer tires. Estimated damage was \$630.00

On Saturday, April 26, 2026 – Cargo Theft Investigation: Deputy responded to the Mobil Gas Station on Memorial Drive regarding cargo theft from a trailer. Unknown suspect(s) cut the seal and a padlock on the semi-truck trailer which contained clothing. The driver could not determine if anything was taken or not.
