**NEWBERRY SPRINGS CSD STATS APRIL 28, 2026 – MAY 25, 2026**

During the past month, deputies handled 136 calls for service, took 23 reports, made 17 traffic stops and made 6 arrests in the unincorporated area of Newberry Springs.

**MENTIONABLE EVENTS IN THE NEWBERRY SPRINGS JURISDICTION**

On Monday, May 11, 2026 – Possession of Stolen Property Arrest: Deputies responded to a call from BNSF regarding suspects stealing cargo of the train in Ludlow. While driving through Newberry Springs one of the deputies saw a vehicle possibly involved in the cargo theft on Newberry Road and Fairview Road. Deputy conducted a traffic stop and contacted the driver, Derek Rojas. Rojas was found in possession of burglary tools and 3 boxes of stolen cargo from the train valued at about \$1160.00. Rojas was arrested and booked at the jail.

On Tuesday, May 12, 2026 – Felony Warrant Arrest: Deputies responded to a residence on Falcon Road regarding a suspicious person call. Deputies contacted Daniel Kiehlmeier, who was found to have an active no bail violation of probation warrant. Kiehlmeier was arrested and booked at the jail.

On Friday, May 15, 2026 – Burglary Investigation: Deputy responded to the Coppi Mumford Community Gardens located on Lakeview Avenue regarding a break-in to a shed on the property. Between May 13<sup>th</sup> and May 15<sup>th</sup>, unknown suspects forced open the shed and stole a Predator 6500 generator with the letters "NSEDA" and the full name "Newberry Springs Economic Development Association" written on it. Also, stolen was a 220-watt electric cord. Case is still active at this time.
