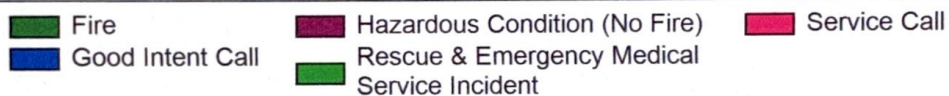
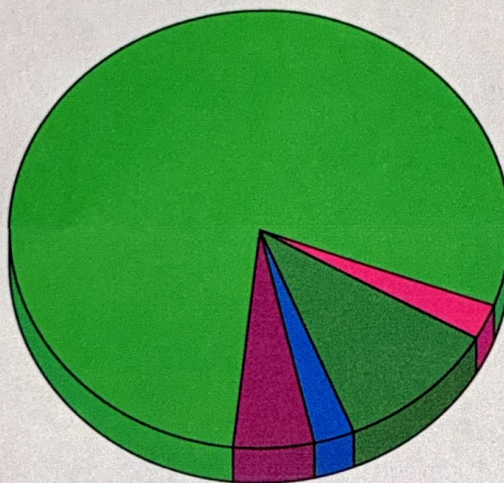

***TRAINING IN HOUSE:**

- (12) Hours In house & hands on.
- (69) FF's online computer Training & or EMT re-certification
- (64) Hours of Certified Training or academy outside of Newberry Fire
 - A. Daily or Shifts Check Outs – Medical bags, Trauma Bags & Fire Apparatus
 - B. FireFighter 1 Task Books (On Going Process)
 - C. EMT Training, Back-boarding, ICEMA reports, Trauma assessments, etc....
 - D. Now we have Certified State Fire Marshal Instructors- we're working on putting together a 6-12 month certified training courses for our firefighters.

***NSFD MONTHLY STAFFING & BP392:**

- *BP392- Approx. Hours Staffed (120) hrs, & in those (120) hrs BP392 ran (18) calls.
 - (5) 24 HR Shifts @Station 392's Sleeping Quarters, (10) 911 Calls while on shift
 - (16) 911 calls responded from Home
- *FireFighter Roster: Local FF's (6), Reserves (8), with total (14) Firefighters
- *BP392, Rescue Trailer & 300 gallon skid, we would like to sell these (3) items to be able to purchase a Type3 brush engine (& or use FD savings \$38,501.64). We'll need to advertise
- NOTE: as of Aug. 19th Newberry Fire has a command unit donated from Calimesa's Chief Lindley & The City of Calimesa. It is a "08" chevy suburban, ready to go with minor changes, all radios are ours as well (all worth approx. \$40,000-\$45,000)

- *(OTS)Office of Traffic Safety-Tentatively approved for "2027-Regional Crash Response & Extrication improvement Program" (\$58,500.00 extrication tools)
- *FY26 State Farm FF Grant-REWARDED \$10,000.
- *FY25-26 AFG and SAFER grant
- *(April 2026 started working on "NORTH Property" Grants)
 - #1) SPP Grant for a Community park
 - #2) Extreme Heat f / Cooling hub project (New Community Building)
 - #3) CRC Emergency Operation Center Project for Fire Dept.
- *REMINDER: "NORTH PROPERTY" located on NEWBERRY RD x of Mendocino RD. Spans 20 acres and has been on NCSD's radar since 2020. In 2024, Fire Dept. had requested to purchase this property. NCSD purchased the property in 2025. Meetings from Civic Hub's past committee & NCSD has always had discussions of a park "extension of our existing park" (to only IDENTIFY TO OUR GRANT WRITER! "South Park" located @30884 Newberry Rd), with a new CSD Community building with a "Cooling Center", a new Fire Dept., with a Fire Dept Training Facility, along with grass or lake Park, Gymnasium and could be so much more.....
- *North Property Address (requested in April) we're waiting for GM/NCSD to retrieve this while we're trying to finish the grants.
- *July 3rd Fri 16:00-21:30 Newberry's Firework show was fantastic & not one complaint.
- *July 4th Sat. 09:00- (Legions) Parade had 31 participants. FD had a Blast with a friendly community water war.
