

POLICY XXX – DIRECTOR REPLACEMENT BETWEEN ELECTIONS

BACKGROUND

District Directors represent the public interests of the District residents.

Directors are normally democratically elected by District residents during regular General Election cycles held every two years.

This Democratic election of Directors is staggered. Three Directors are elected during one two-year General Election cycle and the two other Directors are elected during the next two-year General Election cycle.

BETWEEN ELECTION REPLACEMENT OF DIRECTORS

If a Director resigns for any reason or if a Director is replaced or dies while in office, a replacement Director will be selected to serve the balance of the elected Director's term.

This replacement Director selection process needs to resemble, as closely as possible, the democratic process that takes place during a regular General Election.

First, the selection process will be widely publicized for at least two weeks.

Second, a period of at least two more weeks will be allowed for applicants to apply.

Third, a public CSD Special Meeting will be held when the public can both hear and question all the applicants.

Finally, the District Board will vote on which applicant to select.

The applicant that gets the highest number of votes is selected. In the event of a tie vote, a coin toss will decide the chosen applicant.
