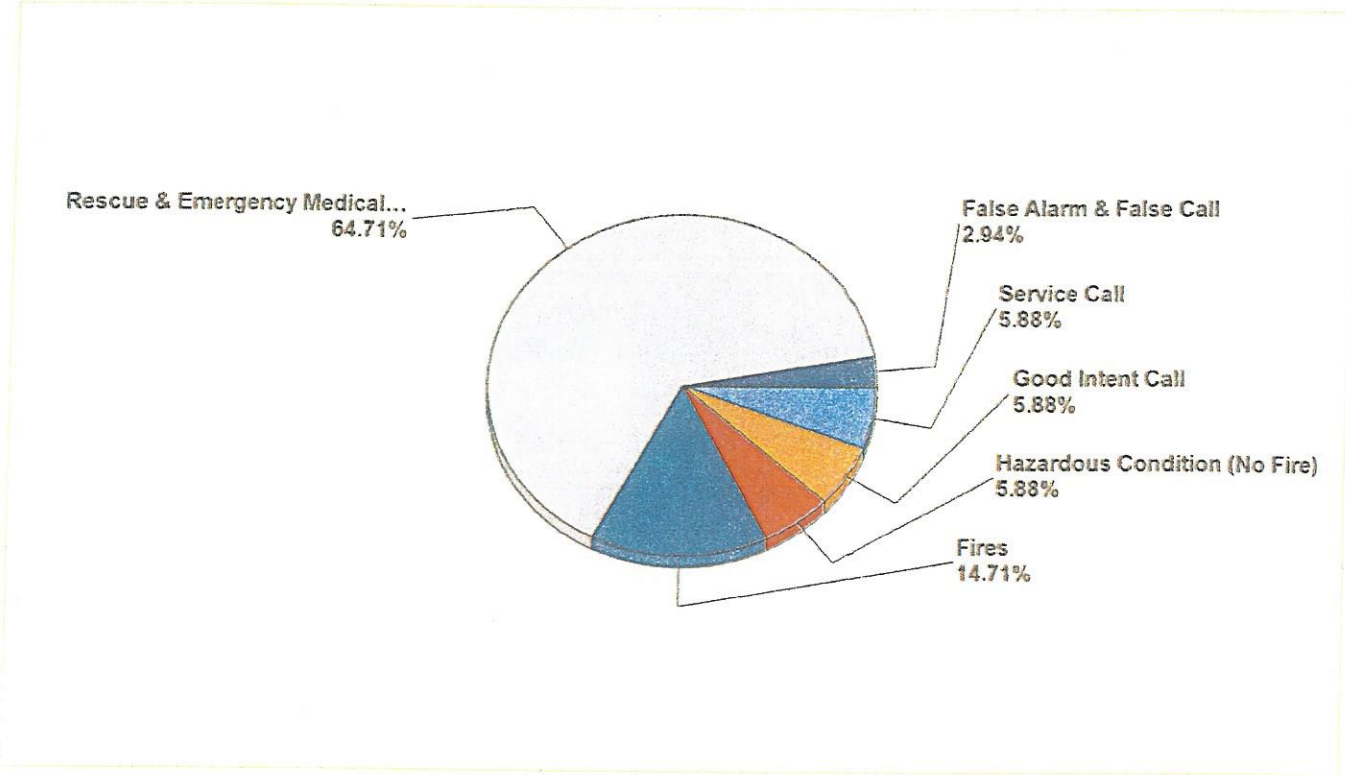

Training attendance: March 2 had 9 attendees, March 9 no data, March 16 had 6, March 23 had 7, March 30 no data.

E 392 was down much of March for fuel system and valve train repairs. \$7599.60 fuel system, \$8080.39 for the valve train.

The third event involved a portion of the valve train and was covered 100% by American including tow and delivery to Station 392.
